SVVA is designed as a peer education program to increase campus awareness about sexual violence and its impact on men and women through comprehensive and innovative education. A variety of informative outreach programs targeting predatory drugs, intimate partner violence, date rape risk reduction, and “For Men Only” have been offered and well received by the campus community.

To participate in SVVA, individuals must attend a training program prior to becoming an advocate. The training will be offered on campus in September, 2008, and will be scheduled based on participant availability. Volunteers are asked to make a commitment of **one academic year** of service with SVVA following training.
